Writing the Resistance: London/Belfast/Dublin 2020 Excursion Itinerary

This trip, travel schedule, guest speaker content, and curriculum were planned and executed by Megan Cramer (Theatre) and Dr. Lauren Holt (English/Literature) for The Galloway School's Excursion program.

What sorts of historical moments are momentous enough to demand action? How do individuals leverage their voices into instruments of change? How will you? Throughout the histories of Great Britain and Ireland, dramatic writers recognized their power to make and perform political statements, creating new texts and adapting nationally sanctioned plays to subversive ends.

Together we traveled to London, Belfast, and Dublin, immersing ourselves in the world of socially responsive theater, performances that are directly responding to and shaping and reshaping their country's divisive histories and cultures. By the end, students conceived and created short group or solo responsive pieces (i.e. poem, short story, scene, monologue -- either written or performative) to call attention to a shared challenge, offer solutions to a national problem, and call on and empower their audiences to take action and make change.
